Georges Daniel Véronique was born in 1948 (Port-Louis, Mauritius), has been Professor Emeritus (French Linguistics and Creole Studies) at the University of Aix-Marseille since 2016.

From 1994 to 2005, he held the position of professor of linguistics and didactics at the Paris III-Sorbonne Nouvelle University. From 2005 to 2012, he taught French linguistics, Creole studies and the didactics of French as a foreign language at the University of Provence, then from 2012 to 2016, at the University of Aix-Marseille.

His research focuses on contact languages, foreign language acquisition, French Creoles and didactics of French as a foreign language.

G.D. Véronique is the present President of the International Committee of Creole Studies (CIEC) and the Association for the Promotion and Dissemination of Creole Studies (APRODEC) since 2012.
